

The special meeting of the Beaverton Rural Schools Board of Education was called to order by President Zdrojewski at 5:30 p.m. in the high school media center. President Zdrojewski led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENT: Members Zdrojewski, Frei, Clark, Grove, Reader and Superintendent Wooden.

ABSENT: Member Colton and Burns.

Administrators present: Quick.

The Board reviewed the 14 Characteristics (the 4 required ones under Domain 1 and the 10 Board-identified ones from remaining Domains from the November Workshop) and how they link to the School Advance Summative Rubric.

Superintendent Wooden shared with the Board the Staff and Public Survey questions and her Board Evaluation results from her 2017 Performance Evaluation. Discussion followed.

Consensus of the Board was to review trending data, student data and the questions for the staff and public survey component of the evaluation at the March 12, 2018 meeting.

President Zdrojewski stated that the Board will also review a Memorandum of Understanding between the Board of Education and Superintendent Wooden relative to an adjustment to the final performance evaluation date when all student performance data and information is available which is normally after April 1.
