Additions to the Agenda. Student Discipline Hearing – Student B

Motion by Colton, supported by Burns, to approve the December 10, 2018 agenda as amended. 7 yes, 0 no – motion carried.

Motion by Colton, supported by Burns, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting November 26, 2018, as presented. 7 yes, 0 no – motion carried.

10 A Retirement Notification

Motion by Frei, supported by Colton, to accept the retirement notice from Fay Lewis effective June 30, 2019, with thanks for her years of service to Beaverton Rural Schools. 7 yes, 0 no – motion carried.

10 B New Hire (2) – Paraprofessionals

Motion by Zdrojewski, supported by Colton, to hire Jodi Flansburgh and Terrie Sheehan as paraprofessionals for Beaverton Rural Schools. 7 yes, 0 no – motion carried.

10 C Student Discipline Hearing Student A

Principal Roberts presented the information to the Board for the discipline hearing for Student A. Student A and the parents were not in attendance, therefore, the Board reviewed the information in open session.

Motion by Zdrojewski, supported by Grove, to expel Student A as recommended by Principal Roberts. Student A may petition the Board for reinstatement after 180 school days. 6 yes, 1 no (Colton) – motion carried.

10 C Student Discipline Hearing Student B

Motion by Frei, supported by Colton, to go into executive session at 7:21 p.m. at the parent's request to discuss a student discipline hearing, Student B. ROLL CALL VOTE: Colton, Clark, Burns, Grove, Zdrojewski, Frei, Reader. 7 yes, 0 no – motion carried.

The Board returned to regular session at 7:43 p.m.

Motion by Colton, supported by Clark, to expel Student B that was subject to a disciplinary hearing on December 10, 2018, as recommended by Principal Roberts. Due to the educational needs of Student B, arrangement will be made to continue offering education at an off-site location. This student may petition the Board for reinstatement after 180 days. 7 yes, 0 no - motion carried.
